August White: TYDY Sauvignon Blanc, Loire Valley, France

We think some of the best Sauvignon Blanc comes from the Loire Valley in France, and this bottle from Thierry Delaunay is no exception. The limestone soil of the Loire Valley brings out this grape's best, most characteristic qualities. We recommend enjoying this wine with goat cheese, cold shrimp or your favorite summer picnic.



August Red: 2007 Castello Monsanto Cabernet Sauvignon, Tuscany

This is spectacular Cabernet from Monsanto (no relation to the corporation), who were the first winemakers to plant French varietals in Tuscany. It is aged 10 years and would usually retail for \$50. You can think of the Sauvignon Blanc this month as being a bonus bottle. This bold, full bodied and earthy wine should be enjoyed with red meat and other hearty foods.
